

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Saturday November 24th, 1917 at 10:00 A.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that from and after this date the Overseer of the Poor be allowed mileage at the rate of 4¢ per mile.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor was authorized to transfer \$100.00 from Dog Fund to Overseer of Poor Fund.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that Supervisor publish the H.B. & M. Report at a charge not to exceed \$10.00.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that Acting Town Clerk write the County Engineer calling his attention to the very dangerous condition of the Middle Country Road in the Town of Brookhaven and leading to Camp Upton.

WHEREAS the Yorkville Bank of New York has presented to the Acting Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead five bonds of Riverhead Water District which mature on Dec. 1st, 1917 and demand payment thereof according to their terms and the amount due thereon being the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollars and interest, and whereas the amount of such principal to wit: Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollars has been inserted in the Tax Levy of said Town for the year 1917; therefore be it resolved that this Board in anticipation of the Taxes for the current fiscal year borrow upon the faith and credit of the Town the sum of Five Thousand

(~~\$~~5000) Dollars for the purpose of paying the principal of said bonds so due as aforesaid by issuing a temporary certificate of indebtedness in said ~~amount~~ payable on the 1st day of February, 1918 at a rate of interest not to exceed 5% per annum signed by the Supervisor and Acting Town Clerk and that the proceeds thereof be placed to the credit of the Supervisor and by him paid to the holder of said bonds upon the surrender and cancellation thereof.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
