

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the office of Justice Hildreth Wednesday evening, June 3, 1908 at 7 o'clock.

A representative of the Buffalo Steam Roller Co. was present with the view to interest the Town Board in the purchase of a steam roller.

Mr. Conn, representing the N. Y. & N. J. Telephone Co. was present in relation to the matter of removing the telephone poles from the highway from Upper Mills to the new railroad bridge at the Forge. He stated that the changing of these poles at this time, which he considered a very busy season, would mean a serious loss to the company and requested on behalf of the company that the matter be delayed until September when they would attend to the matter. On motion the request was granted.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, that the Raynor Avenue extension be accepted by the town and the sum of \$100 be transferred from the Dog Fund to the Highway Account for use on the road.

The sum of \$200 was also on motion transferred from the Dog Fund to the Highway Account the same to be used on the River Road in the Calverton district.
