Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried Health Officer Terrell was authorized to sell the Stove used at the Temporary Hospital to Wm. H. Mott for the sum of \$12.00.

The resignation of Justice Geo. W. Hildreth was presented and accepted by the Board to take effect Jan. 3d 1918.

On motion Robert Burnside, Esq. appointed as Justice of the Peace in and for this Town to fill vacancy in that office occasioned by the resignation of Geo. W. Hildreth, Esq. the former incumbent of such office. Such office to be held by said Robert Burnside, Esq. until and including the 31st day of Dec. succeeding the next biennial Town Meeting. Such appointment to take effect Jan. 3d, 1918.

On motion seconded and carried Justices Flanagan and Downs were appointed a committee to act with Town Supt. of Highways C. O. Downs for the purpose of determining the amount due Robt. W. Duvall for said loam used by the Town of Riverhead from property of said Robt. W. Duvall on East Main Street, Riverhead. Such committee to report as soon as convenient. . .
