

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 21, 1945 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 7, 1945 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that A. John Doscinski be and he hereby is appointed Police Chief of the Town of Riverhead for the duration of the war and six months thereafter, salary fixed at the rate of \$2500.00 per annum, and further

Resolved, that Halsey Corwin, John Bilski, William Fleischman, George Cooper, William Shaddock, Robert G. Leonard, Fred H. MacGlaflin and Harold Bowden be and they hereby are appointed Police Patrolmen of the Town of Riverhead for the duration of the war and six months thereafter, salary fixed at the rate of \$2000.00 per annum each, and be it further


Resolved, that this resolution is subject to any rights that returning Servicemen may be entitled by Law. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0, The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Smith it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Co. be authorized to change the 80 C.P. street lamps to 600 C.P. on Poles Nos. 21, 24 and 27, East Main Street in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of March 15, 1945 and on motion and vote the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 4, 1945 at 2:00 P.M.
