

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, May 2nd, 1945 at 2:00 P. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday, April 18th, 1945 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Department of Agriculture and Markets relative to a change in Assessor's fees for mileage. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the County Treasurer's Office also relative to the change in Assessor's fees for mileage. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik, it was RESOLVED that the rate for Assessor's mileage fees be fixed at the rate of six cents per mile as per Chapter 862, Section 123 of the Agriculture and Markets Law. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes, submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of May 1st, 1945 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police and Welfare reports for the month of April, 1945 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer from the Current Surplus Account to the Assessor's Office and Other Expenses, the sum of \$120.97. The vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$150.00 from the Town-Wide Sidewalk Project Account to the General Town Current Surplus Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on May 16th, 1945 at 2:00 P. M.
