

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 3, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on November 19, 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Notice of Public Hearing on the application of Thomas J. Quinn for a renewal of a bus franchise for a period of five years was read and on motion and vote was duly adopted.

Proof of publication of the notice of the above public hearing was read and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly thereupon declared the hearing open and anyone who wished could be heard at that time.

No one wishing to be heard for or against the application, the hearing was declared closed.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Section 68 of the Transportation Corporations Law of the State of New York as amended, the request of Thomas J. Quinn for a renewal of the franchise to operate a Motor Bus Line in the Town of Riverhead along certain ~~certain~~ highways from the Broohaven Town line to the Wildwood State Park be and the same is hereby granted for a period of five ~~of-five~~ years beginning on the 31st day of October, 1947, and ending October 30, 1952, unless previously terminated and that the Grantee pay the sum of \$25.00 per year for the privilege of operating under and exercising this franchise and consent and further Resolved that a contract be signed to that effect. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$1630.50 from the Current Surplus Account to the following accounts:

The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor

Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$225.60 from the General Town Surplus Account to the Highway Bridge Fund (Item 2) Account for the purpose of paying the deficit on the Brookhaven-Riverhead Town Bridge on River Road. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town Board of Riverhead request the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission to hold a Civil Service examination for the position of Police Patrolman as soon as possible for the reason that there are two vacancies at present in the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead request Harry T. Tuthill, County Superintendent of Highways to release the sum of \$6000.00 from the Highway Reserve Fund, Item #1, Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The matter of Planning and Zoning for the Town of Riverhead was discussed at length by the Town Board with the consensus of opinion that the proposition should be presented to the people with a minimum amount of rules and regulations. The matter was ordered placed on the calendar for the next Town Board meeting for further discussion.


The Supervisor's report for the month of November, 1947 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A statement of vote cast at the annual election of the Riverhead Fire District held on Tuesday evening, December 2, 1947 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town and highway machinery bills to date.
