

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 3, 1953 at 2:00 P.M.

Edward W. Connors, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were also present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 20, 1952 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved, that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place one 100 C.P. Street Light on Pole No. 18, Hallock Street and one 100 C.P. Street Light on Pole No. 26, Merritts Pond Road in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

A communication was read from the 606 Rockaway Corporation together with a map of a proposed road between Osborn Avenue and Route 58 to be known as Delores Avenue and asking the Board to accept the said road as a town highway, as shown on the map. On motion and vote the matter was referred to the Town of Riverhead Planning Board for its consideration.

The Police report for the month of August, 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner offered the following/which was seconded by Justice Yousik,

WHEREAS, the death of Forrest G. Downs has caused a vacancy in the office of Receiver of Taxes in the Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead or a majority of the members thereof, is authorized by law to fill the vacancy by the appointment of a suitable and qualified person to serve until the successful candidate for such office is duly elected at the next annual election and thereafter qualifies, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead is desirous of filling the vacancy which presently exists in the aforesaid office, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, do hereby appoint Charles Allen Horton of said Town to be the Receiver of Taxes for the Town of Riverhead, such appointment is effective September 1, 1952 and is to continue until such time as a duly

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electd Receiver of Taxes is chosen by popular election at the next annual election and thereafter qualifies. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly No. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion and vote it was Resolved, that Ordinance No. 9, Town of Riverhead be referred to the Town of Riverhead Planning Board for study and recommendations for the purpose of amending the said Ordinance. The

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved, that the Town of Riverhead purchase one new International Pickup truck from the Long Island Produce and Fertilizer Co. Inc. for the sum not to exceed \$1345.00 plus the trade in value of the 1939 Chevrolet pickup to be used for the Park Department. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was there upon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved, that Ida Vail be and she hereby is appointed as a temporary clerk to the Board of Assessors to serve at the pleasure of the Board, salary fixed at the rate of \$8.00 per day. *The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.*

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that the appointments of Isidore Danowski and I.S. Hendrickson as School Patrolmen for the Calverton School and the Jamesport School respectively, be terminated as of this date. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that William A. Skarka of 649 Northville Turnpike, Riverhead New York be appointed School Patrolman for the Calverton School and Walter L. Robertson of 4th Street, South Jamesport be appointed School Patrolman for the Jamesport School under the supervision of the Chief of Police and at the pleasure of the Town Board, salary fixed at the rate of \$1.35 per hour. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik and Gatz Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$1281.78, Highway Machinery Fund-\$40.94.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 17, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.
