

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Saturday February 15th, 1919 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Meeting was called for the purpose of making highway appropriations for the ensuing year.

Town Supt. Lane requested that the Motor Vehicle fees be set aside for permanent improvement of the part of Roanoke Avenue commencing at Main St. and ending at L.I. R.R. Tracks.

On motion seconded and carried the following highway expenditures were agreed upon.

Expenditures (as agreed upon.)

1- Average per mile \$150 for 150 miles	32500
2- For repair and construction of culverts, sluices and bridges having a span of less than five feet and removal of waterbreaks	850
3- Total special appropriations	3203.23
4- Reserve fund	6294.54
5- Payment of orders Nos. 1 to 234 inclusive, for expenses incurred and paid from the 1st day of November to date of this agreement	4236.30
Total	<u>37083.07</u>

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor Howell was authorized to have an Arc Light placed at corner of 2d St. and Roanoke Avenue Riverhead Village.

On motion seconded and carried Town Supt. of Highways Lane was authorized to advertise for bids for 100,000 gals. of road oil.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that Justice Flanagan and Town Supt. of Highways Lane, go to Albany at the Town's expense and interview the State Highway Commission and obtain all possible information regarding the new State Highway to be built within the Town of Riverhead.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
