

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 5, 1945 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 22, 1945 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A public notice from the United States Engineer's Office advising the Board that an application has been made by the Harbor Sound Realty and Development Corporation, 500 Fifth Avenue, New York, N.Y., successor to The Friars Head Land Corporation, for an extension of time in which to maintain the work authorized under permit issued by the Division Engineer, North Atlantic Division, on May 3, 1940. By unanimous consent of the Board, there was no objection to the request for an extension of one year.

Supt. of Highways Young advised the Board that the Firemen wish to run a bazaar for three days in the west end of the highway barn and asked the Board if there would be any objection. There was no objection on the part of the Town Board.

The Police report for the month of August 1945 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a statement of the taxes remaining unpaid upon the assessment roll of the Town of Riverhead for the year 1944-45. On motion and vote the statement was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the resolution which was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead on August 8, 1945, appointing Wallace Seaman Jr. as Police Patrolman be and the same is hereby rescinded. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Wallace Seaman Jr. be and hehereby is appointed Provisional Police Patrolman for the Town of Riverhead subject to the Civil Service Rules, <sup>rescinded as of August 1, 1945</sup> salary fixed at the rate of \$2000.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Arthur Dort, Isadore Danowski and L. Gilson Griffing be and they hereby are appointed School Traffic Officers for the Town of Riverhead at the Aquebogue School, Calverton School and Jamesport School respectively and be it further

RESOLVED that they serve at the pleasure of the Town Board from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M., 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M., and 3:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. on school days, salary fixed at the rate of 75 cents per hour. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.


A petition signed by approximately 100 resident taxpayers requesting the Town Board to establish a garbage district in the Town of Riverhead in the same territory as now covered by the Riverhead Sewer District. The petition was ordered placed on file.

It was the unanimous opinion that the Town Board visit the various Garbage Collection Districts in the County on Wednesday, July 19, 1945 to ascertain facts and figures ~~is to~~ to present to the taxpayers of the proposed District.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that a Public Hearing be held by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 26, 1945 at 8:15 P.M. on the matter of the contract between the Riverhead Fire District and the Riverhead Fire Protection District and it is further Resolved that the Town Clerk give due notice thereof by proper publication pursuant to Law. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 19, 1945 at 8:30 A.M.
