

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Tuesday February 13th, 1918 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Meeting called for the purpose of determining the places where and the manner in which, the moneys levied and collected in said town and received from the State as State aid shall be expended for the repair and improvements of Highways.

After listening to suggestions and remarks of various citizens, an agreement was entered into between Chas. O. Downs, Town Supt. of Highways and this Board as follows.

It is agreed that we hereby set aside primary work and general repairs upon the highways in said town an average sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars per mile, for 150 miles, which is the total mileage of highways within the town as determined under sections 69 and 102 of the Highway Law.

It is agreed that we set aside for the repair and construction of sluices, culverts and bridges, having a span of less than five feet, and for the removal of waterbreaks or so-called thank-you-ma'ams, the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars.

It is also agreed that we set aside the following sums for the permanent improvement of highways, exclusive of sluices, culverts and bridges a span of less than five, ^{feet} but including tile draining at such points as may be directed by the county superintendent upon the following named roads:

(A) On the road commencing at Depot Land, Aquebogue


and leading to Jamesport, N.Y. distance of 2 miles there shall be expended the sum of \$1000.00 for the following kind of improvement, breaking up, oiling and graveling for a width of 16 feet with graveling of 3 inches in thickness. (This sum to be used as part of Motor Vehicle fees received by Town).

(B) On the road commencing at Railroad Bridge west of Riverhead and leading to Raynor Avenue, Riverhead a distance of 2 miles there shall be expended the sum of \$955.98 for the following kind of improvement, breaking up, oiling and graveling for a width of 16 feet with graveling of 3 inches in thickness.

The following items are made a part of the agreement.
