of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday
June 6th, 1919 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion, seconded and carried the following ordinance
was adopted and ordered published two times in the local
papers, and the Town Clerk was ordered to have necessary
number of cardboard copies printed and distributed about
the town.

NOTICE

The following ordinance was adopted at a
Town Board meeting held on June 6, 1919:
Resolved, That pursuant to the provisions
of Article 9 of the General Municipal Law of
the State of New York, the Town Board of
the Town of Riverhead does hereby enact the
following ordinance:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person
to ride within the Town of Riverhead a bi-
cycle, tricycle, motorcycle or any similar ve-
hicle on any sidewalk or side path made, used
or maintained for the use of pedestrians.

Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person
to ride within the Town of Riverhead a bi-
cycle, tricycle, motorcycle or any similar ve-
hicle unless the same shall be equipped with a
bell, whistle or other audible signal, which
may be heard 100 feet distant.

Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person
to ride within the Town of Riverhead a bi-
cycle, tricycle, motorcycle or any similar ve-
hicle between one hour after sunset and one
hour before sunrise unless the same shall have
attached thereto or carried therewith a light
of such illuminating power as to be plainly
seen 200 feet ahead.

Sec. 4. Any person violating any of the
provisions of the ordinance shall be punished
by a fine not exceeding the sum of \$5 for each
offense and in case of the non-payment of
such fine, by imprisonment in the county jail
not exceeding one day for each dollar of such
fine in the discretion of the court or magis-
trate.

ABOVE ORDINANCE WILL BE STRICTLY
ENFORCED

On motion, seconded and carried, Bond of Joseph W. Kratoville, Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead in the sum of \$1000.00 was approved.

On motion, seconded and carried it was ordered that Supervisor, B. Frank Howell be authorized to have appointed such Special Deputy Sheriffs as he might deem necessary to act on July 3d and 4th, 1919.

Mr. James F. Richardson, Dr. Raimon Petty and Mr. Geo. W. Hildreth appeared before the Town Board and asked that suitable medals be presented to those enlisted men of the Town of Riverhead, who served this Country in the World War 1917-1918 by the Town of Riverhead and that the expense of such medals be a charge against the Town of Riverhead.

On motion, seconded and carried the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead on behalf of the People of said Town voted to spend the necessary funds to provide a suitable medal for each of the enlisted men of the Town of Riverhead, who served The United States in the World War 1917-1918 and for each family of the men, who died in the service of the United States, and also to provide the necessary funds to erect a permanent Memorial Tablet and the erection thereof in a suitable public place in the Village of Riverhead, in honor of all those who have so served Our Country in the World War 1917-1918 and in memory of the men, who gave their lives for Our Country.

On motion, made, seconded and carried Supervisor B. Frank Howell was authorized to have appointed a Special Deputy Sheriff to regulate traffic on Main Street in the Village of Riverhead such days and nights as the Supervisor might deem necessary at the rate of \$4.00 per day on Saturdays and Holidays, and \$3.00 per day on week days.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
