Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion, seconded and carried the following polling places were designated for this year and a list of such polling places was filed with the Board of Elections, Riverhead, N.Y.

On motion, seconded and carried Howard V. Lane, Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead was authorized to purchase for the Town of Riverhead 20,000 gallons of road oil at not exceeding the contract price of .0589 per gallon.

On motion, seconded and carried it was ordered that the Town Superintendent of Highways Howard V. Lane be authorized to increase the pay of laborers and foreman on the roads of the Town of Riverhead as follows from and after July 1st, 1919.

Laborers from 27¢ per hour to 30¢ per hour.
Foremen from 30¢ per hour to 34¢ per hour.

On motion the consent of Howard V. Lane, Town Superintendent of Highways to place a Victory Arch on Main Street in the Village of Riverhead and to rope off Griffin Avenue for the night of the 4th of July from Court Street

to Second Street was accepted and placed on file.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
