

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 15, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 1, 1952 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

An Order from the New York State Public Service Commission was read as follows: Case 15732 - Petition having been filed with this Commission by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County relative to the protection provided at the grade crossings of the tracks of the Long Island Rail Road Company and Sweezy, Maple, Union and Ostrander Avenues, in the said Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, and said Town Board having requested permission to amend its petition by including the crossings at Osborne Avenue, Griffing Avenue, Roanoke Avenue, East Avenue and Main Street, in the said Town of Riverhead, and the Commission having determined that said request of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead be granted, it is - O R D E R E D: That the amended petition of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead be considered in this proceeding and the title of the proceeding be changed as above set forth. The Order was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the resolution adopted August 20, 1952, authorizing the Littlefield Alger Signal Co. to install a traffic signal light at the intersection of Northville Turnpike and Elton Street for the sum not to exceed \$1200.00 be and the same is hereby rescinded, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that the Littlefield Alger Signal Co. be authorized to install a traffic signal light at the intersection of Northville Turnpike and Elton Street for the sum not to exceed \$1987.00. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisors Report for the month of September, 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the amount of \$3,681.70 from the Current Surplus Account to the following accounts:

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place one 100 C.P. street light on Pole No. 26 on Ackerly Street, east of Roanoke Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Justice Yousik offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Gatz,

Whereas, the Supt. of Highways of the Town of Riverhead has recommended the purchase of one Model B, Tiltop Trailer at a maximum estimated cost of \$2,000.00, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, New York meet at the Town Hall, Riverhead, New York on the 5th day of Novemeber, 1952 at 2:00 P.M. to consider such purchase and that the Town Clerk give due notice thereof, pursuant to Section 142 of the Highway Law. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date the total of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$4754.16, Highway Machinery Fund-\$196.32.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 5, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.
