

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday June 8, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on May 25, 1938 and minutes of a meeting held on June 1, 1938 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Wading River Civic Association calling to the Board's attention several dangerous conditions which exist on Wading River due to its narrow winding roads and asked the Board to cooperate in improving these conditions. The communication was ordered placed on file.

Mrs Katherine Van Nostrand, Traffic Committee of the Wading River Civic Association addressed the Board in regard to the above matter and requested the Board to take some action especially in front of Raffe's store and the curve by the old Fleming place. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

A communication was read from Mr J. Leo Saxstien, Attorney, in reference to the rumors to the effect that the property of Mr Sylvester Cavanaro on East Main Street is to be acquired for a parking field, stating that if the Board contemplates negotiating for a parking field in that vicinity, to eliminate the property of Mr. Cavanaro. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report was submitted for the month of May 1938 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Homan advised the Board that W.P.A. will start work on the Aquebogue Sidewalk Project next Monday and that Engineer Wolf of W.P.A. requested the Board to appoint a purchasing agent for the project.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Kelly it was Resolved, that Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways be designated as purchasing agent for the W.P.A. Aquebogue Sidewalk Project. The vote, Justices Zaleski, Kelly, Warner and Boutcher, yes, Supervisor Homan, yes. Total vote, yes 5, No. 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 29, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.
