

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 4, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on November 20, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Public Notice of a hearing in the matter of the application of Henry W. Adelworth and Vitus F. Adelworth, as co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of THE BLUE LINE, for consent to operate a Motor Bus line in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York was read.

Proof of publication of the above notice was presented to the Board and was ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly thereupon declared the hearing open and anyone who wished could be heard at that time.

No one having appeared in opposition to the above application the hearing was declared closed.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the Transportation Corporations Law of the State of New York as amended, the request of Henry W. Adelworth and Vitus F. Adelworth, as co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of THE BLUE LINE, for consent to operate a Motor Bus Line in the Town of Riverhead be and the same is hereby granted for a period of five years and that the Grantee pay the sum of \$15.00 per year for the privilege of operating under and exercising this franchise and consent and further Resolved that a contract be signed to that effect. The vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Proof of Publication of the notice of consideration, by the Town Board of the purchase of two trucks and an automobile for the Riverhead Highway Department, each of which exceed the sum of \$500.00, pursuant to Section 143 of the Highway Law was submitted to the Board, and ordered placed on file.

No one having appeared in opposition to the purchase of the ^{above} two trucks and automobile for the Riverhead Highway Department, on motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase one four wheel drive Walters Snow Fighter F6KD at a price not to exceed the sum of \$13,125.00. The Vote,

Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED, that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase two new trucks for the Highway Department, one not to exceed the sum of \$5000.00 and the other not to exceed the sum of \$5500.00. The vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5 No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase a new automobile for the sum not to exceed \$1200.00 plus the trade in value of the old car. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Yousik offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Leonard

WHEREAS, the Town Board did on the 17th day of April, 1946, ~~did~~ authorize the purchase of a Tractor-loader, after due publication pursuant to Law, and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of said tractor-loader has increased in price since that time, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Supt. of Highways be authorized to purchase ^{the} a tractor-loader for a sum not to exceed \$7000.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from John A. Rolle tendering his resignation as School Patrolmen for the Town of Riverhead, effective as of today. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the resignation of John Rolle as School Patrolman be and the same is hereby accepted as of today. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that I. S. Hendrickson be appointed School Patrolman for the Town of Riverhead and be it further Resolved that he serve at the pleasure of the Board from 8 A.M. to 9 A.M., 11 A.M. to 1 P.M. and from 3 P.M. to 4 P.M. at the Jamesport School, salary fixed at \$.75 per hour. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from the New York State Dept. of Agriculture and Markets, requesting the Board to appoint a Dog Enumerator for the year 1947. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Howard A. Wells be and he hereby is appointed Dog Enumerator

for the Town of Riverhead for the year 1947, salary fixed by the State Department of Agriculture and Markets. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Town Clerk be authorized to execute in the name of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead a receipt of the payment by the Trustees under the will of Cora B. Reeve Barnes, deceased, to the Town of Riverhead of the sum of \$2000.00, being the full amount of the legacy bequeathed to it under Subdivision 10 of Paragraph "SEVENTH" of the Will of said Cora B. Reeve Barnes, Deceased, and that he further be authorized to release and discharge the Suffolk County Trust Company and Orville R. Young, individually and as Executors under the Will of Cora B. Reeve Barnes Deceased, and Adrienne E. Van Rossum and the Suffolk County Trust Company, individually and as Executors under the Will of Walter F. Barnes, a Deceased Executor and Trustee from any and all obligations to it, arising by reason of the last Will and Testament of said Cora B. Reeve Barnes, Deceased, so far as the payment of said legacy to it is concerned, and further be it

RESOLVED, that the said sum of \$2000.00 be deposited in a Special Account for the purposes expressed in said Will of Cora B. Reeve Barnes, Deceased. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Sealed bids from S. Leavitt, Inc. and Louis Frank on prices for new uniforms for the Police Patrolmen were opened by the Board. On motion and vote the bids were referred to the Police Committee with power to act.

A statement of vote cast at the annual election of the Riverhead Fire District held at Riverhead, New York on Tuesday, December 3, 1946 was submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report for the month of November/was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of November, 1946 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the generous offer of Mr. L.Y. Robinson to dedicate a small portion of his property at the intersection of Corwin Street and Ostrander Avenue to the Town of Riverhead for the purpose of widening the Highway at that point was accepted and further Resolved that the Town Attorney be requested to prepare the proper forms for the dedication. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Board of Assessors appeared before the Town Board in regard to the 1946 Suffolk County Tax Equalization Table.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved, that the Town of Riverhead appeal to the New York State Tax Commission from the decision of the Board of Supervisors in the equalization
