

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board as a Board of
Audit, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Saturday, March 26,
1904.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was pre-
sented and approved.

22 bills, amounting to \$617.66, and 6 Board of
Health bills, amounting to \$104.65, were audited.

On motion the sum of \$200. was appropriated to the
Overseer of the Poor out of the Contingent Fund.

The report of the Highway Commissioner was approved.
There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
