Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs and Counselor
Cecil B. Tooker addressed the Board relative to the proper
procedure of establishing sidewalks at Jamesport and on
Fishel Avenue, Riverhead.


Supt. of Highways, Charles O. Downs was directed
to ascertain if sidewalks are still desired in these localities
and to obtain a list of the property holders in these sections.

The opinion of Counselor Edward T. Coyle regard-
ing the protection afforded the Town under the proposed Gas
Franchise of the L.I. Lighting Company, was submitted to the
Board.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that Mr. Stoltz,
of the L.I. Lighting Company be invited to attend a Meeting
of the Town Board of Riverhead, in order to better acquaint
the Town Board with their proposition regarding a Gas Franchise.

Justice Corwin and Supt. of Highways Chas. O.
Downs advised the Board that they had seen Mr. Felt, who owns
the strip of land which is desired by the Town to straighten
the Road leading to the Beach at Wading River but had nothing
definite to offer at this time.
