

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 17, 1952, at 2:00 p.m.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday, December 3, 1952, were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Harry G. Penny, Secretary of the Riverhead Fire Department, enclosing a report of their election held on December 2, 1952. The communication and report were ordered placed on file.

Re: Jan
Charles Allen Horton submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of December 16, 1952 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of November 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town Board meet at the Town Hall on Tuesday, January 6, 1953, ^{at 2:00 p.m.} at which time it will consider the purchase of a sweeper for the Highway Department for a sum not to exceed \$10,000. and that the Town Clerk publish notice thereof pursuant to law. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Mrs. Ella Cheshire be and she hereby is appointed a part-time clerk in the Office of the Receiver of Taxes retroactive as of December 8, 1952, salary fixed at the rate of \$8.00 per day, and further Resolved that Mrs. Rena Downs be appointed part-time clerk in the Office of the Receiver of Taxes retroactive as of December 11, 1952 salary fixed at the rate of \$8.00 per day. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Leonard it was resolved that the following bonds be approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety:

The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice
Warner it was Resolved that Frank J. Smith and William L. Miller, Sr.
be engaged to appraise the several properties that are now used as
the Town Parking Field on the South Side of East Main Street along the
Peconic River and that Alden W. Young, Engineer, be engaged to
make the necessary appraisal maps. The Resolution was adopted by
the unanimous vote of the Board.

Dewey Lewin of Calverton, N.Y. submitted maps of certain
proposed highways located at Wading River ~~for~~ acceptance as Town
Highways.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice
Yousik it was Resolved that the matter of the acceptance of the
proposed roads submitted by Dewey Lewin as Town Highways be referred
to the Town of Riverhead Planning Board for its consideration. The
resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and
examined all Town bills to date the totals of which were as follows:
General Town Fund-\$2180.58 and Machinery Fund-\$1082.63.

There being no further business on motion and vote the
meeting adjourned to meet on Monday, December 29, 1952 at 9:00 a.m.
