Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Committee appointed to assist State Commissioner of
Highways in matter of Middle Country Road improvement
reported that Commissioner Duffy had been interviewed and
he promised to start work as soon as possible. Also reported
that several Gravel Beds had been located in the vicinity
of the road to be improved.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that
Justices Burnside and Miller constitute a committee to
inquire into the question as to whether or not the fees of
Assessors should be raised to \$5.00 per day and
disbursements.

On motion seconded and carried a resolution was duly
adopted recommending the issuance of a Summer Hotel Liquor
Tax Certificate to I. Seymour Corwin for premises in

Town of Riverhead known as Hotel Miamogue property at
South Jamesport, County of Suffolk and State of New York
north side of Front Street.
