

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Saturday, November 19th, 1927 at 10.00 A. M.

The meeting was called for the purpose of adopting a budget for the year 1927 and 1928, and before taking a vote on the budget, Supervisor Howell advised all taxpayers present that the Board would be glad at this time to have them express their views on this matter.

\$5000.00 for straightening curb line, paving curb and gutter, commencing at the northwesterly corner of the abuttment of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street and continuing westerly on Main Street to Griffing Avenue, thence northerly on Griffing Avenue as far as possible.

\$2500.00 for curbs and gutters in the section of the town near the Polich Church.

\$2500.00 for curbs and gutters as occasion may demand.
