Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that
report of Board of Assessors certifying to the correctness
of bill of Dennis G. Homan for 46 drakes killed by dogs.
Such bill amounting to \$122.50 be accepted together with
affidavit of Mr. Homan to the effect that he could not
learn identity of owner or owners of the dog or dogs and
further ordered the claim presented to the Board of Audit.

In the matter of alteration of the River Road as set
forth in application of Sarah H. Smith dated Mar. 15th, 1918
and filed in Town Clerk's Office on this date, it was on
motion seconded and carried, ordered that the Town Supt.
of Highways make an order altering the highway known as the
River Road at the bridge crossing the tracks of the L.I.R.R.
known as the Forge Bridge, as defined in the aforesaid
application of Sarah H. Smith.
