

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office On June 8th.1927 at 4 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of June 1,1927 were read and on motion approved.

A communication received from the Public Service Commission, Albany, New York, advising of a public hearing on June 17th.1927 at 10:30 A.M.at 120 Broadway, New York City, in regard to the petition of the Long Island Lighting Company to construct a gas plant (extention) in the Town of Riverhead was read.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to represent the Town of Riverhead at the public hearing of the Public Service Commission at 120 Broadway New York City, in regard to the Petition of the L.I.Lighting Company for a Gas Franchise.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note the sum of Three Hundred and FIFTY and 00/100 (\$350.00) Dollars to pay the interest due on Water Bonds of the Town of Riverhead.

The Committee consisting of Justice Penny and Town Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs advised that they had ascertained from Percy I. Bergen that he would ask the sum of One Thousand Dollars for the land desired by the Town to ease the corner at Jamesport at the abuttment of East Jamesport Lane and the Main Road and that he would want a sidewalk in front of his property.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the motorcycle officer at Jamesport be allowed the sum of \$2.00 per day for expenses.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that a Petition of which the following is a copy, be made and signed at this time by the entire board and that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to present the same, for the purposes therein specified, to the Board of Supervisors of Suffolk County, New York.
TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, New York:-

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, did on the 1st day of June 1927, petition and request the State Division of Highways of the State of New York to modify the plans for the construction and improvement of the Coram-Middle Island, East, County Federal Aid Highway, Project No 448, to provide for a width greater than two feet, than that originally contemplated by the said State Division of Highways, and to construct and improve such highways at such increased width, at the cost and expense of the said Town of Riverhead, and

WHEREAS, the State Division of Highways thereupon prepared modified plans, specifications and an estimate of the cost to be borne by the Town of Riverhead, for such extra width, which cost was fixed at the sum of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000) Dollars, and

WHEREAS, on the first day of June, 1927 a resolution was duly adopted by the said Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, approving said modified plans specifications and estimate of the cost to be borne by the said Town, and appropriating the sum of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.) Dollars, being the amount required of said Town for such cost as aforesaid, including five per cent (5%) for engineering charges, and

WHEREAS, on the first day of June 1927, the Town Board of said Town of Riverhead, duly adopted a resolution providing that the said share of the cost of construction and improvement of said highway to be borne by the said Town, in the amount of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.00) Dollars be raised by the issue and sale of town bonds pursuant to Section 138a and 142 of the Highway Law, and other statutes in such case made and provided, and that the said Town Board petition the Board of Supervisors of the County of Suffolk for authority to borrow the said sum of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.00) to pay the share of the cost of the construction and improvement of said highway which is to be borne by the said Town of Riverhead as aforesaid, and for authority to issue and sell Town Bonds therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred upon us by Sections 138a and 142 of the Highway Law and in accordance with the with the said resolutions of the Board

we, the undersigned, all members of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, do hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board to authorize and empower the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, to borrow the sum of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000.00) Dollars to pay the share of the cost of the construction and improvement of said highway which is to be borne by the Town and to issue and sell its bonds therefor under and upon such terms, conditions and restrictions as your said Board may legally impose.
