

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on January 26th. 1927 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of January 13th. were read and on motion approved.

On motion and vote it was Resolved That the Town of Riverhead, accept the assignment of Anna Danilson of her award of \$1700.00 in the Jeffries Highway Proceeding to Ostrander Realty Corporation, and Resolved, That the Town Clerk be and he hereby is authorized and directed in the name of the Town Board of Riverhead, to acknowledge receipt of such an assignment.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the bill of Frank H. Corwin for badges be paid.

On motion and vote the Town Clerk was authorized to publish in the local papers and have hand bills printed requesting the public to assist in handling traffic near the school by discharging children or persons going to school only on the west side of Roanoke Avenue between Fourth Street and Fifth Street; by making no left hand turns into the school grounds; by not parking on either side of Roanoke Avenue between Fourth Street and Fifth Street during school hours.

Charles O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, requested the Board to have steps taken to have the North Road defined and laid out.

On motion and vote Charles O. Downs, Supt of Highways was authorized to obtain counsel and a surveyor to look up the records in Riverhead and Southold Towns in regard to the North Road and report back to the Board at its next meeting the results of their findings.

Charles O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, addressed the Board stating that the Long Island Lighting Company had requested him to advise them as to their right to place a pole in front of the farm of Harold Robinson on the North Road. The opinion of the Board was: This Highway not having been defined as a Town Highway, this matter of placing a pole on the North Road in front of the farm of Harold Robinson is entirely between Harold Robinson and the Long Island Lighting Company.

The Town Clerk read a letter addressed to the Town Board of Riverhead from S. Ormond Goldan of 25 West 74th. Street, New York City., a taxpayer in Suffolk County protesting against the Building Program of the Board of Supervisors of Suffolk County and requesting them to amend their program.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the communication of of S. Ormond Goldan be placed on file.

The matter of an increase of compensation for the Receiver of Taxes was taken up by the Board.

The Town Clerk was authorized and directed to obtain a legal opinion as to the authority of the Town Board to increase the salary of the Receiver of Taxes during his term of office.

On motion and vote the Meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, February 8th. 1927 at 2 P.M.
