

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Wednesday, September 28th. 1927 at 2 P. M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, of August 31, 1927, September 9th. 1927, and September 12th. 1927 were read and on motion adopted.

A communication from Park V. Arnold, Commercial Manager of the Riverhead Office of the L. I. Lighting Company, in regard to cost of installation and maintenance of a new system of street lighting for the business section of Riverhead, was read and referred to the Lighting Committee.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the following resolution was duly adopted:

RESOLVED that Lighting District No. 1 of the Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk and State of New York, be, and the same is hereby extended to include therein all the real property lying within the territory described below, and said Lighting District No. 1 of said Town of Riverhead shall hereafter be bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at the Southwesterly corner thereof at a point formed by the intersection of the Peconic River with the center line of the Highway known as Upper Mill Dam Road, or a continuation thereof; running thence Northerly along the center line of Upper Mill Dam Road to the center line of West Main Street or State Highway No. 25; running thence Westerly and Northwesterly along center line of said West Main Street or State Highway to the center line of Mill Road; running thence Northerly along center line of Mill Road to the Northerly line of the land of the L. I. Railroad Company; thence Easterly along said Northerly line of the land of the L. I. Railroad Company to the Westerly line of the Riverhead Water District as the same is laid out and shown on a map of said Water District filed in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead, New York, on the 25th. day of March 1914, and which point, according to said map, measured at right angles from the center line of Baynor

Avenue, is distant 740 feet Westerly therefrom; running thence Northerly by and with the said Westerly line of said Water District and a continuation thereof feet; thence Easterly to the center line of Raynor Avenue, running thence Northerly along the center line of Raynor Avenue to the center line of Osborn Avenue; running thence in a straight line at right angles to the center line of Roanoke Avenue to a point distant 20 Rods Westerly from the Westerly side of Roanoke Avenue; running thence Northerly and parallel with the said Westerly line of Roanoke Avenue, to the center line of Middle Road; running thence Easterly along the said center line of Middle Road to a point in said line distant forty rods Easterly, measured at right angles to the center line of Roanoke Avenue from said center line of Roanoke Avenue; running thence Southerly and parallel with the center line of Roanoke Avenue to a point where a line drawn due West from the center of the Saw Mill Brook as it passes below the Northville Turnpike at Mike Grabas Duck Farm would intersect said North and South line; thence due East to the center ~~line~~ of said Saw Mill Brook where it crosses said Northville Turnpike; running thence Southerly by and with said Saw Mill Brook as the same winds and turns to the Peconic River; thence Westerly by and with Peconic River as it winds and turns to the center line of the Upper Mill Dam Road at the place of beginning.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the L. I. Lighting Company be notified to extend the street lights within the above described lighting district by installing twenty street lights from their present termination on Riverside Drive to the extreme end of Riverside Drive.

The lighting committee reported on the petitions for an additional street light on East Avenue, Maple Avenue and for additional street lights at Wading River within the Lighting District, recommending that these petitions be granted.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was Resolved that the L. I. Lighting Company be notified to install a street light on East Avenue, between First Street and Main Street, a street light on Maple Avenue, near Main Street and 15 additional street lights within the Lighting District at Wading River, on Wading River Road as far as the residence of Leonard Blumgart.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Town Clerk be authorized and directed to have notice of Election, Registration and list of officers to be filled at the Election to be held on November 8th. 1927, published in the local papers.

Cecil B. Tooker was present and presented the Opinion of Nathan O. Petty and Cecil B. Tooker regarding the Water Commissioners of the Riverhead Water District.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the opinion of Nathan O. Petty and Cecil B. Tooker in regard to the Water Commissioners now holding office in the Riverhead Water District, be accepted and filed and that this matter be held over for some future meeting of the Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note the sum of Seventeen Hundred Sixty Four and 25/100 (\$1764.25) Dollars to pay on account of audited bills of September 27, 1927.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Thursday, October 6, 1927 at 6 P. M.
