

Minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held Tuesday March 28, 1899.

9 A. M. Board met at the Town Clerk's Office and adjourned to the Town Hall.

Present:

The Justices examined the Overseer of the Poor and Highway Commissioners account and audited the Constables and Deputy Sheriff's Bills. The Town Clerk and Supervisor audited the Justice's bills and the full Board audited the Miscellaneous bills.

\$500 Liquor Tax was voted to the use of the Overseer of the Poor and \$150.74 Liquor Tax was voted to the Board of Health.

On motion \$50 was voted for the defrayment of the expenses of observation of Memorial Day.

11 A.M. Recess taken until 1 P.M.

1 P.M. Board reassembled, same members present.

The Reports of the Overseer of the Poor and Commissioner

of Highways were accepted and approved.

The following resolution was adopted.

RESOLVED: that the Dog Fund amounted to \$307.55, Justice's Fines \$342. and the balance of the Liquor Tax \$500.31 be and hereby are transferred to the Contingent Fund.

Claim of Robert Creighton as Scavenger \$52. was not allowed.

The Commissioner of Highways appeared before the Board with an estimate of appropriations amounting to \$1545. which he desired to have voted at the Town Meeting, (In addition to the \$500. allowed by law) in each of the two ensuing years whereupon on motion the same was recommended.

On motion the Board recommended that the Town vote to raise \$500., or so much thereof as may be necessary for Contingent Fund in the years 1899 and 1900.

22 Bills amounting to \$476.03 were audited and allows.

Motion Meeting adjourned.
