

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, December 29th. 1927 at 3 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Board, held December 12th. 1927, were read and on motion adopted.

A petition for an additional street light at the junction of Fishel Avenue and Main Street, signed by taxpayers and residents of Fishel Avenue, was read, and on motion and vote, was held over for the next meeting of the Town Board.

A communication received from the State of New York, Department of Audit and Control, in regard to New York Employees' Retirement System was read and held over for the next meeting of the Board.

A petition of the Lions Club, requesting the Town Board to limit the hours of parking in the business section of Riverhead, to two hours, between the hours of 9 A. M. to 5 P. M., was read and on motion and vote, held over for the next meeting of the Board.

The tally of Vehicle Traffic at the corner of Main Street and Griffing Avenue and at the corner of Main Street and Roanoke Avenue was read. Following appears the tally of said traffic count;

The bond of Dennis G. Homan, Supervisor Elect, in the amount of \$50,000.00, by the Fidelity and Casualty Company was presented to the Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED, that the bond of Dennis G. Homan, Supervisor-Elect, by the Fidelity and Casualty Company, in the sum of \$50,000. filed with the Town Clerk, December 29th. 1927, be and the same hereby is approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety.

Mr. Alonzo Danilson was present, and addressed the Board in regard to the highway crossing the L. I. Railroad at Ostrander Avenue and advised the Board that Mrs. Anna Ostrander Danilson would dedicate her right of way across the said tracks of the L. I. Railroad to the Town of Riverhead.

On motion and vote, Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was instructed to have the necessary document drawn up, for the release of the right of way of Mrs. Anna Danilson over the tracks of the L. I. Railroad at Ostrander Avenue to the Town of Riverhead.

The description of the highway known as Main Street from the L. I. Railroad Crossing at East Main Street to about one mile west of the Village of Riverhead, to accompany the map as drawn up and presented at a previous meeting of the Town Board, was presented.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that Town Superintendent of Highways, Charles O. Downs proceed to file an order in the Town Office, laying out Main Street as per map and description presented.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
