Bid of the Riverhead Electric Light Co., reading as follows, was adopted:

We will furnish seventy-eight (78) incandescent lights of 25 candle power each and light the Riverhead Village, lighting District every night from one half hour after sun down until one o'clock, for one thousand dollars per year, for the term of three years from date.

On motion, the Bid of the Riverhead Electric Light Co. was accepted.

Highway Commissioner Edwards appeared before the

Board with an application to lay out road in western part of village and, on motion, Supervisor Fanning and Justice Buskingham were appointed a committee to investigate the title of land.

On motion, Highway Commissioner Edwards was given power to purchase one Road Machine at a price not to exceed \$160.
