

A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead was held at the Town Clerk's Office Monday, August 21' 1899 at 3.30 P.M.

All members being present except Justice Daniel A. Young.

The Town Clerk read a petition which had been filed with him, remonstrating against a grant of land under water at Wading River to George W. Heatley by the Commissioners of the Land Office.

Mr. Jos. M. Belford addressed the Board on behalf of the Petitioners.

Mr. Buckingham offered the following resolution which was adopted.

Whereas a petition has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead protesting against the granting of land under waters of the Long Island Sound at Wading River to George W. Heatley, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead do hereby strongly oppose the granting of any land under the waters of the Long Island Sound within the limits of said Town to any private person or corporation except for docking privileges; and the Town Clerk is hereby instructed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the Commission-

ers of the Land Office and to the Board of Supervisors of  
Suffolk County.
