Minutes of Chapter 54 Public Hearing held at Riverhead Town Hall, Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, on Thursday, May 27, 1999 at 1:00 p.m.

Barbara Grattan, Town Clerk: "Let the record show that the hour of 2:24 p.m. has arrived and the public hearing of Delphine and Warren Booker of 9 Zion Street, Riverhead is now in session."

Adam Grossman: "Regarding the continuation of this public hearing, I would like to ask Leroy Barnes, the administrator of the Building Department to speak in connection with the applicants, not the applicants, the affected party, Anthony Caluzzi, whether he has had any correspondence or any further information follow-up regarding this property from Mr. Caluzzi or his legal counsel.
