

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Suffolk County Board of Supervisor's Room, Court House on Wednesday, May 3, 1944 at 10:30 A.M.

The Town Board and the Finance Committee of the Board of Supervisors discussed the matter in regard to the Sewer Assessments on the County propriétés. After much discussion, it was mutually agreed, that the matter should be held over until a later date when all data could be submitted to another joint meeting.

On motion and vote the Town Board recessed at 13:00 o'clock noon to reconvene at at 2:00 P.M. at the Town Hall.

The Town Board reconvened at the Town Hall at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney was present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on April 19, 1944 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A petition signed by several residents and taxpayers requesting the Town Board to lay concrete sidewalks and curbs on both sides of Pulaski Street between Griffing Avenue and Roanoke Avenue. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

A communication was read from Capt. Arthur A. Wagner of the Suffolk Air Base requesting the Town Board to establish a "bus stop" on West Main Street in front of the Westend Diner for the convenience of the soldiers and officers and the bus which is regularly running between the Suffolk Air Base and the Town of Riverhead.

On motion and vote the Town Board established the last forty feet on the West side of Osborn Avenue from West Main Street for the above purpose.

The Police and the Welfare reports for the month of April 1944 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

Justice Warner reported on the matter of the renewal rents and the purchase prices asked by the owners of the several properties which make up the Roanoke Avenue-Griffing Avenue Parking Field. It was the unanimous opinion of the Board, that if more favorable terms could not be obtained from some of the above property owners, there is a possibility that the Roanoke Avenue Parking Field may have to be abandoned.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills for the month of April, 1944.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, May 17, 1944 at 2:00 P.M.
