

The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Tuesday, September 5' 1899 at 1 o'clock P.M.

The following places were designated as Election places in said town.

Dist. No. 1	Wading River Hall
" " 2	Town Hall
" " 3	Riverhead Hall
" " 4	Hockabock

The Resignation of Edgar W. Scribner, Inspector of Election Dist. #2 was read and the same accepted.

On motion Henry C. Major and Joseph Conklin were appointed Inspectors of Election in the Districts 1 & 2 respectively.

On motion Lorimer M. Raynor was appointed Truancy Officer in and for the Town of Riverhead at a compensation of \$2# per day for actual services rendered and 5# per mile for each

and every mile traveled.

"The following Act was presented and adopted.

"An Act to licanse and regulate Venders, Shows, Concerts and public amusements in the Town of Riverhead."

The authority to pass this resolution is found in Chapter 332 Laws of 1890.

SEC. I. On and after September 11' 1899, it shall not be lawful for any traveling circus, show, concert, merry-ground, vender or public amusement to exhibit, sell or parade in the Town of Riverhead until a license therefor has been obtained from the Town Board of said Town.

SEC. II. Such license will be granted by the Town Clerk upon payment of such fee as three members of the Board shall deem just and proper.

Mr. George W. Heatley appeared before the Board relative to the action taken at the last meeting touching his last application for a grant of land under water at Wading River and introduces his Counsel, Mr. Winans, who spoke at some length in favor of the grant and requested that the Board rescind its resolution.

Mr. Belford, Counsel for the opponents addressed the Board in support of the resolution.

After considerable discussion the Board, on motion, went into Executive Session.

Mr. Buckingham offered the following resolution which was unanimously adopted.

RESOLVED: that this Board do reaffirm the passage of the resolution passed at its meeting held August 21' 1899 in relation to the grant of land under waters of Long Island Sound within the limits of this Town.

On motion the Board went into regular session and adjourned.
