Minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board as a Board of
Town Auditors, held at the Town Clerk's Office Saturday, Nov.
18, 1899 at 9 o'clock A.M.

On motion the Justices were appointed Committee on Con-
stables and Sheriff's Bills and the full Board acted on all
other bills except on bills presented by members of the
Board who had no voice in the auditing of their own bills.

1.30 Reassembled, same members present.

The following resolution was presented by Daniel R. Young
and adopted.

RESOLVED: That no bills will be audited by
this Board for services as Attorney in road matters unless
such Attorney be employed by the Commissioner of Highways.

The Town Clerk made a statement in relation to the
Indexing of Births, Marriages and Deaths, whereupon, Daniel

R. Young offered the following resolution, which was adopted.

RESOLVED: That the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to index the records of Births, Marriages and Deaths in his office, and that the Supervisor, on the completion of the same, pay to the Clerk the sum of Fifty dollars therefor.

75 bills were audited, 65 of which amounted to \$1298. 35 were town bills and 10 amounting to \$118.01 were Board of Health Bills.

Certificates of bills audited were made out and signed by the Board and the meeting adjourned.
