

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board, as a Board of Audit, held in Town Clerk's Office, November 13th, 1903, at 9 A. M.

On motion, meeting adjourned to Town Hall.

On motion, the Justices of the Peace were appointed a Committee on Constable and Sheriff's bills, and the full Board acted on all other bills, except that members had no voice in the auditing of their own bills.

1.30 P. M. Board re-assembled.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was presented and accepted.

71 Bills, amounting to \$1956.21, and 11 Board of Health bills, amounting to \$215.69, were audited.

Motion made that there be inserted in the Tax Levy

the sum of \$5500. to be used for highway purposes for the year 1904. Motion carried.

On motion, the sum of \$30000 was appropriated to the Overseer of the Poor, out of the Contingent Fund.

On motion, the Supervisor was instructed to have inserted in the tax levy for the ensuing year, the sum of \$831.55 for new roads.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was presented, examined and approved.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
