

Minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held at the Town Clerk's Office Saturday, Dec. 30' 1899 at 2 o'clock P.M.

Joseph M. Belford, Attorney for Hawkins Brothers presented a petition, as follows:-

The petition of Edward Hawkins, Simeon S. Hawkins, Ebenezer Hawkins, and Jedediah Hawkins of Jamesport, Suffolk County, New York, respectfully represents:

That they are the owners of certain real estate at Wading River, in the said County, known as the Wading River Mill property. That the original grant of such land was made by the Trustees of the Town of Brookhaven in May 1708.

That one of the conditions of the said grant was the perpetual maintenance of a Mill

That the Town of Riverhead subsequently succeeded to all rights of the Town of Brookhaven in said grant or so much thereof as lay to the East of Red Brook.

That the Town of Brookhaven in 1878 quit claimed to one
Georga Hawkins the brother of your petitioners, all its title
and interest in the premises described in the said grant.

That the necessity for maintaining a mill at said place
has long since disappeared and its perpetual maintainance
may prove a great hardship to your petitioners.

Wherefore your petitioners pray your Honorable ^{Board} to release
and quit claim to them any interest which the said Town of
Riverhead may have in the premises herein referred to.

Hawkins Brothers by Edward Hawkins.

sented to this Board be granted; and that this Board execute
to said Hawkins Bros. a quit claim deed or release of the
interest of the town of Riverhead in and to the property
known as the Wading River Mill property and referred to in
said petition.

On motion of Daniel R. Young the Supervisor and Town
Clerk were appointed a Committee to procure a Seal of suit-

able design as the Town Seal.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
