The Justices were appointed Committee on Constables and Deputy Sheriffs Bills; all other Bills were audited by the full Board.

On motion the Liquor Tax Fund amounting to \$1135.97 was ordered transferred as follows: to the Contingent Fund \$500. to the Overseer of Poor \$635.97.

The Report of the Overseer of Poor was examined and on motion was approved.

Report of Commissioner of Highway was examined and on motion was approved.

The Justices Fines \$161<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and Dog Fund \$306.10 were on

motion transferred to Contingent Fund.

The Board recommend that there be voted in Town Meeting the following appropriations \$500 additional for Highway purposes, \$500 for Contingent Fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, and \$250 for Board of Health.

The Board recommend that an appropriation of \$125 be voted for purchase of Election Booths.

Bills were audited amounting to \$667.19
