

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, July 13th. 1932 at 2 P.M.

Raymond S. Welch, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

Minutes of the Town Board meeting held June 29th. 1932 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

A communication was read from W. H. Gosman of Wading River, N.Y. advising of damage to property caused by water from highway. This communication was referred to the Sup't. of Highways and the Highway Committee for investigation.

A communication was read from the State Department of Education of Albany, N.Y., advising that an Attendance Officer should be appointed by the Town Board previous to August 1st 1932.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Lorimer M. Raynor be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Officer of and for the Town of Riverhead for the School Year 1932-33, and be it further Resolved That the Compensation of said Attendance Officer be and the same is hereby fixed at \$5.00 per day for each day actually on duty and \$.15 per mile expenses for each mile traveled in the performance of his duties.

The Highway Committee, reporting on the Highway matter at Wading River, advised that they were unable to find a record of the laying out of a highway from the Landing Road at Wading River to Wading River Creek, but were advised that William L. Miller, a surveyor residing at Wading River had prepared and submitted a map to the Town of Riverhead of said highway in the year 1912, and were further advised by residents of Wading River that this road had been opened and used for the past fifty years, and that, in view of their

findings were of the opinion that the Road was a Town Highway and should be kept open.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the report of the Highway Committee in connection with the highway extending west from the Landing Road to the Creek at Wading River be accepted and that the Town Clerk be and he hereby is instructed to obtain a copy of map made by William L. Miller in 1912, which is said to have been submitted to the Town of Riverhead in the year 1912 and be it further Resolved That any and all obstructions be removed from the highway and that this highway be kept open to the Wading River Creek.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the Town Clerk be instructed to have notice of the Ordinance pertaining to Hawking and Peddling which was adopted at a Town Board meeting on June 29, 1932, published in two issues each of the Riverhead News, The County Review and the Island News and that said Ordinance be effective as of August 1, 1932.

Mr. James G. Giannakakis addressed the Board, requesting that he be allowed to sell ice cream and other refreshments at a stand which he desires to erect at the Town Park. This matter was referred to the Highway Committee with power to act.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 27th 1932 at 7:30 P.M.
