

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on July 11, 1927 at 2 P. M.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the Lighting Committee was authorized to have a map made of the Lighting District after the District has been laid out and defined.

The Lighting Committee reported that they had obtained the cost of the contemplated new street lights and standards and were now waiting to obtain the cost of installation for same.

Supervisor Howell reported having received the sum of \$8626.41 from the County Treasurer, same being the Town of Riverhead's share of the State Income Tax to June 30, 1927.
