Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 3, 1951 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 29, 1950 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Association of Towns of the State of New York advising that its Annual Meeting will be held beginning at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday February 6th and ending at noon on Thursday, February 8th, 1951. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor, Justices of the Peace, Town Attorney, Supt. of Highways, Town Clerk, Assessors, Clerk to the Assessors, members of the Town Planning Board and the Consultant to the Town Planning Board be authorized to attend the Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns to be held on February 6th to 8th, 1951 and that all necessary expenses be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that Supervisor Joseph V. Kelly be designated the Official Representative and Justice Austin H. Warner be designated the Alternate Representative to the Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns of the State of New York. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of December 1950 and the Annual Police Report for the year 1950 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of January 2, 1951 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Suffolk County Trust Company, Suffolk County National Bank and the Long Island State Bank and Trust Company be and they hereby are designated as depositories in which the Supervisor, Town Clerk and the Receiver of Taxes of this Town shall deposit all moneys coming into their hands by virtue of their offices. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the News-Review of Riverhead, N.Y. be and it hereby is designated the official newspaper of the Town of Riverhead for the year 1951. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.
