

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Friday, September 9th. 1927 at 11 A. M.

Mr. A. O. Smith, County Engineer and Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs were present.

The bids for Curb, Gutter and Sidewalks on Main Street, west of Peconic Avenue, Riverhead, were thereupon opened in the presence of the Town Board and representatives of various bidders.

The bidders and the amount of their bids as aforesaid were found to be as follows:-

On motion and vote the foregoing bids were received and ordered placed on file.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the bid of L. Lotito and Sons, of Patchogue be declared the lowest bidder and be it further **RESOLVED** that the said bid of L. Lotito & Sons, of Patchogue, N.Y. be and the same is hereby accepted and that a contract be awarded to L. Lotito & Sons for work on curb, gutter and sidewalk on Main Street, Riverhead, New York.

The matter of a Special Motorcycle Constable was brought before the Board and it was the opinion of the Board that Special Constable Ryan of Jamesport, should patrol the entire town of Riverhead for the time being.

Almon G. Rasquin representing Hudson V. Griffin, addressed the Board relative to an Election to be held in the Water District of Riverhead, for the Election of Water Commissioners.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the Supervisor seek advice of counsel as to the Town Law in regard to the election of Water Commissioners.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet on Monday, September 12, 1927 at 3 P. M.
