

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Wednesday, January 28, 1931 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held January 14, 1931 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

A petition of property owners bordering the Peconic River, was presented, requesting that the public authorities have charge of regulating the forge dam and referred to the Highway Committee.

A certified copy of Order of the Public Service Commission granting the transfer of certificate from Ernest Naber to Edwin A. Remlein, was presented and ordered placed on file.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That The Road Committee be authorized and directed to investigate the matter of the bridge crossing the Peconic River, near the abutment of Osborn Avenue and West Main Street, with power to employ counsel, if necessary, in order that the Town Board may take steps to have said bridge removed.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes requested that he be authorized to employ a clerk for two weeks and a clerk for three weeks.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes be and he hereby is authorized to employ two clerks for a period of two and three weeks respectively.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday February 11, 1931 at 2 P. M.
