

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, March 11, 1931 at 3 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, held February 25, 1931 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

The report of the Town Nurse, Miss Marion L. Jacobs, was read and ordered placed on file.

The Highway Committee, Justice Frederick and Justice Miller, reported having inspected the Town Dock and recommended that a public hearing be held by the Town Board, in order to ascertain what action should be taken in this matter by the Town Board.

The Board was addressed by Fred M. Lewis, relative to conditions at the Dock and on McDermott Avenue.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That a public hearing be advertised and held in the Town Board Meeting Room on April 1, 1931, at 7:30 P.M. in order that the taxpayers of the Town may have an opportunity of expressing their opinions as to whether the Town should dredge the slip at the Town Dock or fill same in.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Water District Election for the purpose of electing a Water Commissioner for a term of three years in place of Hubert F. Corwin, whose term of office will expire on April 16, 1931 and a Water Commissioner for the unexpired term, in place of George E. Luce, who was appointed Water Commissioner by the Town Board until the next annual election, be held in the Town Office on April 6, 1931 from the hours of 2 P. M. to 4 P. M.

On motion and vote, the Town Clerk was directed to have the necessary notices of the Water District Election posted and published twice in each of the local papers, in the issues of March 27th and April 3rd, 1931.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned.
