Supervisor appointed Geo. F. Stackpole and E. B. Payne Committee on Justices Bills.

D. A. Young and D. R. Young, Committee on Constables and Dep. Sheriffs Bills.

Geo. F. Stackpole and D. R. Young, Committee on Town Clerk and Supervisors Bills and Overseer of Poor and Commissioner of Highways Report.

The Liquor Tax Fund, amounting to \$725.35 was voted to the Overseer of Poor.

Mr. Stackpole votes no to all bills of Constables and Deputy Sheriffs to charges for attending Court. The Committee reported that the charges were really for custody of prisoner and being legal and proper.

A motion was offered and carried, to hereafter allow the Town Clerk 10¢ each for filing papers in his office where there is no specified fee for the same.

Reports of the Commissioner of Highways and Overseer of Poor were examined and approved.

On motion, the Dog Fund of \$391.65, Justice Fines \$202.50, the balance of Board of Health Fund and \$500 collected from the Knoess Estate be transferred to the Contingent Fund.

The Board recommended that there be voted at Town Meeting the following appropriations, \$500 for Highways (additional) \$500 for Board of Health and \$500 or so much thereof as may be necessary for Contingent Fund.
