

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, February 11, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on January 28, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from RCA Communications Inc. and RCA Laboratories, Riverhead, New York, respectfully protesting the resolution which was adopted by this Board on January 21, 1948 in regard to favoring the proposed Airport adjacent to the Town of Riverhead for the reason that the interference with incoming messages by unshielded airplanes renders their service inefficient and unsatisfactory with respect to commercial messages and particularly with respect to radio photos and program materials of international origin transmitted here for rebroadcast and respectfully asked that the Board revoke the said resolution and that if the matter is to be again considered, a hearing be called for that purpose after public notice. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A delegation from RCA was present and Justice Yousik asked just what effect the proposed Airport would have upon them.

Mr. Harold A. Taylor and Mr. Elliott Rundquist representing RCA explained in detail the technical effect that unshielded airplanes would have on their communications.

Justice Warner stated that the resolution of January 21st was made only in regard to the benefits to the Town of Riverhead.

The Board advised the representatives of RCA that the matter would be given consideration.

A petition signed by several taxpayers fronting on East Avenue Extension requesting the Board to change the name of the town highway now known as East Avenue Extension to POND VIEW ROAD was read. The petition was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town Highway now known as East Avenue Extension be and the same is hereby changed to be known as POND VIEW ROAD. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Supervisor Kelly advised the Board that Davis Bros., the owners of a portion of the Roanoke Avenue Parking Field have returned the check in the amount of \$275.00 for the 1948 rental, stating that they have no

agreement with the Town of Riverhead.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Davis Bros. be advised that the rental of \$375.00 per annum for their portion of the Roanoke Avenue Parking Field is not acceptable, their portion of the field will be abandoned as of March 1, 1948. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month of January 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Tax Receiver's report as of February 2, 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of January 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

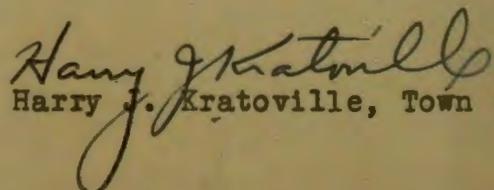
On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the resolution of the Riverhead Yacht Club in regard to the improvement of the water fronts of the Town be referred to the Riverhead Town Planning Board for its consideration. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to change the 80 C.P. light to a 300 C.P. light on Pole #177 on Roanoke Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Mr. Garret Hiers and Mr. William McGrath representatives of the International Parking Meter Company explained in detail the workings of the dual parking meter and the agreement that the Company would offer to the Town of Riverhead, should the Board accept this meter.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town and highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, February 25, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.
