The Board of Town Auditors of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Hall, Saturday November 7th, 1896.

All members present.

The following resolution was adopted.

WHEREAS, It has come to the notice of this Board that many persons in the Village of Riverhead, are of the opinion that the compensation allowed to Robert Creighton, the Scavenger for the Board of Health, is intended to cover for his services in cleaning all privies and cesspools in the Village instead of only such places as are ordered cleaned by the Health Officer, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk give public notice, that all persons are to pay for cleaning their own privies and cesspools, and that no bill will be allowed to any scavenger unless the same is accompanied by an order from the Health Officer, and whenever the Health Officer orders or directs the Scavenger to clean any privy or cesspool, he shall give immediate notice to a Justice, who shall proceed to collect the cost thereof from the owner or occupant of the premises.

Robert Creighton was voted \$15.00 for services as Scavenger.
