The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Tuesday January 22' 1895 at 1 o'clock P.M.

All members present except Justice Millard.

Supervisor Terry officially notified the Board of a vacancy in the Office of Justice of the Peace, by reason of the death of James L. Millard.

On motion, George F. Stackpole was appointed to fill the vacancy, until Town Meeting.

The necessary certificate was subscribed to by the members and forwarded to the County Clerk.

The Bond of George F. Stackpole as Justice of the Peace having been approved by the Supervisor was filed with the Town Clerk.

George F. Stackpole informed the Board that he had taken the Oath of Office before the County Clerk and took his seat.

On motion, the Supervisor, Town Clerk and Justice Stackpole were appointed to draft suitable resolutions on the death of James L. Millard; and also on the faithful and efficient services of ex-Justice of the Peace J. Halsey Young and to present them to open Town Meeting for adoption.

On motion of George F. Stackpole, it was adopted that

the present arrangements with the Hallett Electric Light Co.  
be continued until the further action of this Board.
