

The Town Board met at the Town Clerk's Office Tuesday March 26' 1895 at 9 o'clock A.M. and immediately adjourned to the Town Hall.

All members present.

36 Bills were presented and audited, particulars of which will be found in the certificate on file.

Certificate of Assessors on Sheep killed was presented and George E. Luce was allowed \$26 from the Dog Fund.

On motion the Constables bills were referred to the Justices for examination.

Supervisor was instructed to pay to Elbert A. Fanning \$75. under vote of Town Meeting.

On motion the Town Clerk was allowed \$30. for use of his Office for Town purposes for past two years.

\$800. of Excise Moneys were ordered paid to Overseer of Poor, after his accounts had been audited and approved.

Motions adopted to refund \$2.50 to Yetter & Moore and \$9.04 to G. Edward Benjamin the same being over taxation.

Commissioner of Highways Report was approved.

On motion the balance of \$320. Excise moneys, \$240.85 Dog Fund & \$106.50 Justice fines were ordered transferred to Contingent Fund.
