

The Town Board met at the Town Clerk's Office Saturday, Nov. 29' 1895 and adjourned to the Town Hall.

All members being present.

60 Bills aggregating \$1187.02 (including 15 Board of Health) were audited.

The Town Clerk called the attention of the Board to a printed opinion of Hon. A. N. Weller in relation to Town Clerk's Fee, which if correct, he would be entitled to a large sum of money for such services, and desired that some action be taken to determine whether or not the Town was indebted to him; Whereupon the following resolution was presented and adopted.:

RESOLVED: That the Supervisor get opinion from Wilmot M. Smith, as to what the duties of a Town Clerk are and what fees he is entitled to for the same.

Bills of O. A. Hawkins and Wading Riverh Hall, as well as the Deputy Sheriffs and Constables Bills were referred to the Justices of the Peace.

The following resolution was presented and adopted:-

RESOLVED: That after this date this Board will not audit any bills for taking tramps and persons not accused of any crime, before a Justice of the Peace for the discharge of

such person, when the law does not require such discharge.
