

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday October 16th, 1914 at 3:30 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion it was ordered that the following propositions be presented to the voters of the Town of Riverhead to be voted on at Town Election to be held November 3, 1914.

Proposition No.1: Shall there be inserted in the Tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars for the Contingent Fund?

Proposition No.2: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) dollars for the Board of Health Fund?

Proposition No.3: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) dollars for the overseer of the Poor Fund?

Proposition No.4: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of fifty (\$50.00) dollars for the proper observance of Memorial Day, said sum to be payable to the Commander of Henry A. Barnum Post, G.A.R. of Riverhead, N.Y.?


Proposition No.5: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of ninety-six (\$96.00) dollars for the payment of the rent of the post rooms of Henry A. Barnum Post, G.A.R., Riverhead, N.Y.?

Proposition No.6: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars for the purpose of contributing said amount to St. Peter's Hospital of Brooklyn in consideration of treatment of such poor patients as may be sent to such institution from the Town of Riverhead?

Proposition No. 7: Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1915 and 1916 the sum of two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) dollars for the purpose of constructing a bridge over Peconic River at wanorville, where such river is crossed by the Schulz road. Such amount to cover the proportion of the expense to be borne by the Town of Riverhead, the Town of Brookhaven paying the remaining portion?

Proposition No. 8: Shall the Supervisor and Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, N.Y. be authorized and instructed to make a detailed statement at the end of each fiscal year of the receipt and disbursement of all town funds; also shall the Town Board be authorized and instructed to give full information as to election matters and all other interests affecting the taxpayers of said Town, all information provided for in this proposition to be published in the local newspapers of the town?

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
