THOMAS R. COSTELLO and ROBERT G. LEONARD, duly sworn depose and say:

1. That they are duly elected Town Justices of the Town of Riverhead, a second class town and as such are duly elected members of the Town Board.

2. Upon information and belief the duly elected Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead is unavailable to call a special town board meeting to consider and vote upon the matter of AN ACT "To Amend the County Law, in relation to the assessment of costs of sewer districts in the county of Suffolk".

3. The said special town board meeting is called for 10:00 A.M., Friday, February 19th, 1971, to be held at the Town Hall, 220 Roanoke Avenue, Riverhead, New York.

Town Justice Leonard offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

RESOLVED, That in the absence of the Supervisor, Town Justice Thomas R. Costello, be and is hereby designated Temporary Chairman for the Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead on February 19th, 1971.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Leonard, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Zaloga, Absent.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

RESOLUTION

Councilman Grodski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

WHEREAS, Mr. Jerabek of the New York Assembly introduced Bill #1213 entitled "An Act to Amend the County Law in Relation to the Assessment of Costs of Sewer Districts in the County of Suffolk", and

WHEREAS, the said Bill was prefiled on January 6, 1971 and referred to the Committee on Local Government, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead has taken the matter into consideration and its effect on the County as a whole and the Town of Riverhead and the citizens thereof,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead is OPPOSED to the passage of said Bill as it is not in the best interest of the County of Suffolk nor the residents of the Town of Riverhead in that it is discriminatory against those areas that have established and are paying their own cost of sewer improvements, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Law should not be amended regarding the assessment costs of Sewer Districts in the County of Suffolk but should remain as is; viz. that the Sewer District should bear the costs of their own improvements.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Leonard, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Zaloga, Absent.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned at 10:15 A.M.
