

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held in the Town Clerk's office Saturday, Jan. 15, 1909 at 2 o'clock.

Meeting called for the purpose of receiving bids for lighting the Riverhead Lighting District.

The bid of the Riverhead Electric Light Company to furnish the Riverhead Lighting District with 25 c. p. lights to be lighted between sunset and sunrise every day in the year for the sum of \$58.00 per light, was accepted and Justices Taft and Hildreth and Town Clerk Hagen were appointed a committee to draw up a contract between the Riverhead Electric Light Co. and the Town Board.

School Commissioner Howell appeared before the Board in relation to the allowing of horse hire to the Attendance Officer in the performance of his duties.

On motion the Attendance Officer was allowed the sum not to exceed \$1.75 per day for horse hire in addition to the compensation already allowed him.

On motion the Board allowed the bill of L. M. Raynor Attendance Officer, of \$5.50 for horse hire and requested

Town Board of Audit to audit and allow the same.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
